- Owner must provide feed and bedding and portable fencing if you want to keep your horse outside next to your trailer
- All horses must wear a halter or bridle at all times. Portable fencing should be approx. 30' x 30' in size.

SHOWERS & RESTROOMS:

- There are 2 showers at the top of the hill above the Dodge Gilman Building on the left
- Restrooms are available throughout the fairgrounds
